

## Ring Size Guide

Before you measure your ring size using either of the methods outlined below, make sure that you have printed this guide in A4 size, scaled to 100%. To check the accuracy of your guide, position a credit card on the line below. If the card fits perfectly within the outer lines, it is the correct size.

Option 1: Measure using an existing ring
To find your Garrard ring size, use an existing ring that is a good fit. Place it
over the circles below until you find the black circle that is visible through
your ring with no white space showing - this is the correct size. If your ring
falls between two sizes, Garrard recommends choosing the larger size.



Option 2: Measure Using the Garrard Ruler

After cutting out the ruler below, create a slit by carefully cutting the dotted line. Wrap the ruler around the base of your finger, gently pull the pointed end through the slit and read your ring size on the outside of the paper. To ensure your ring is a comfortable fit, we recommend also measuring your knuckle size and selecting a ring size that can comfortably be put on and removed.
